

Persistence/Effort Rubric

Students receive a grade based on the effort they put forth during study skills class toward completion of an assigned task and/or mastery of targeted skill.

Persistence/Effort	Persisting in the face of obstacles; putting forth appropriate effort.
Advanced(4)	<p style="text-align: center;">Worked until done and saw hard parts as opportunities to learn</p> <p>➤ Student remains determined and pursues goals, even when s/he encounters large-scale and complex obstacles.</p>
Proficient (3)	<p style="text-align: center;">Worked until done</p> <p>➤ With minimal encouragement, student persists in pursuing goals when s/he encounters difficulties; abandons tasks or goals only when obstacles are large-scale and complex.</p>
Basic (2)	<p style="text-align: center;">Worked some, but quit when it became difficult</p> <p>➤ Student requires substantial encouragement to persist in seeking goals when obstacles arise; occasionally abandons tasks or goals in challenging situations.</p>
Novice (1)	<p style="text-align: center;">Did Very little work</p> <p>➤ Student abandons tasks or goals as soon as they become too complex or as soon as obstacles are encountered.</p>
